



Resources for the Scholarly Publishing Community in Ukraine

The Society for Scholarly Publishing will make the following resources available to the scholarly publishing community in Ukraine free of charge.

Free access to SSP's OnDemand Library content

The OnDemand Video Content Library is the “anywhere, anytime” source for scholarly communications professionals to learn about timely topics and recent developments in scholarly publishing. This asynchronous learning platform offers a variety of recorded video content that users can access when it’s convenient for them. Videos that are free to view (without registration) are marked with the open lock icon. Check back often as new content is being released monthly.

Registrations fees will be waived, but users must register. Users must include their address, including country when registering online to ensure they are not charged.

Particularly valuable in this collection is the Journals QuickStarter and Books QuickStarter series that provide an excellent overview of publishing practices. Past Annual Meeting, seminar, and webinar content is also available.

Free access to SSP's Webinars and Seminars (virtual participation)

SSP offers approximately 10-12 webinars per year. All webinars are recorded and made available in the OnDemand Library if registrants are not able to participate at the time of initial broadcast.

The New Directions Seminar is a two-day hybrid event that provides scholarly publishing professionals an opportunity to convene and discuss the latest trends and common challenges faced by our industry today.

Free access to SSP's Training Programs (virtual)

SSP offers 2-3 virtual training programs annually. In the past, these have included an Open Access Workshop, and Copyright Workshop and the Journals Academy. The Journals Academy is next up on the schedule (Nov/Dec) and might be particularly relevant for professionals seeking broad information on all areas of academic journals publishing. Attendees will be exposed to

existing and emerging areas of the journals landscape which will help both in their day-to-day duties and as they develop their careers.
